SO FAR:

We have both had our meet and greet conference calls with WSO, and got to hear what WSO expects from our positions.

It is our perception the safety requirements have scared members into not participating and WSO suggests that we encourage everyone to become AMIAS even if they are not interested in sponsoring. This is for back-up resources in case someone's car breaks down or something happens where a member cannot make a meeting, or to generate excitement and encourage members to want to be of service at district and area events.

We have reached out to other areas around the country to ask how they manage their trainings and what works and what does not. So far we have made contact with CA, TX, and have reached out to GA, and OH. We have a call scheduled with TX for next week.
