I will also be asking for 3 Districts to volunteer to research one of the questions and present that research on Sunday morning at Assembly.

At Spring Assembly I asked each of you to share how you, your Groups or Districts promote *The Forum*. Here are your responses:

1. Several members in my home group get *The Forum* and share stories from it at meetings.
2. Always offer *The Forum* to newcomers – Old copies and current copies to share.
3. Pass a coffee can around the room for small change and everyone puts their name on a paper and puts it in the can. After a period of time draw a name and use the money for a subscription to *The Forum*.
4. The monthly Group copy is always given to a member in hopes that they will subscribe for their own.
5. I conduct regular group meetings using *The Forum* and sharing topics and articles that have been vital to my recovery.
6. One meeting a month we discuss an article from *The Forum*. We also announce and encourage subscriptions.
7. Put a *Forum* on each chair and ask members to pick something from it that they can relate to.
8. Our group adds a *Forum* subscription form and a money order to the raffle basket we donate to Assembly and Convention.

These ideas will be shared on a display board at AWSC and also at Fall Assembly.
