Hello, Florida North!! The following is my report to be shared with all your fellow Al-Anon members. Thank you for allowing me to serve as your Area Alateen Coordinator. The role has greatly contributed to my recovery. I recommend this service position to any member who qualifies.

FROM AL-ANON/ALATEEN SERVICE MANUAL 2022-2025:

Area Alateen Coordinators, coordinate the activities of Alateen in the Area and liaise between the Area World Service Committee (AWSC), and the groups. They convey service information from the WSO to the Districts, AISs, and groups. To perform their duties as an Alateen Coordinator they must be certified as an Al-Anon Member In Alateen Service (AMIAS) in the Area they serve. (p.75)

We have conducted 6 scheduled FRESH (Forms Resources Experience Strength & Hope) Events since October 2022, and several others held by districts. **Cindy J (AAPP) and I are always willing to help any District conduct their own virtual FRESH Event.** Not only do we accomplish training and certification of AMIASs during these events, but they are a gathering place for Al-Anon members serving in Alateen to learn what resources are available, share experiences, express concerns, and ask questions of each other. Our FRESH Events are so effective they have become the model for many other Areas around the worldwide fellowship to streamline their training and certification processes.

There will be an Alateen Conference AUG 4-6, 2023! District 3 has stepped up to host, and a venue has already been selected. Phil G, the District 3 Alateen Trainer is the Chairperson. Volunteer help is still needed from AMIASs. If you are not an AMIAS, there are many ways you also can volunteer to help, so please contact Phil with your willingness to contribute.

Judy S and Kayrn M of District 12 will be co-hosting the Alateen Program during the Area 9 Al-Anon Convention 2023. They did an amazing job in 2022 and are anxious to welcome the young members again this year. They, too, need volunteers!!

Please remember, Area 9 will provide \$250 to Districts who wish to hold an Alateen Roundup, an Alateen Family night to spread awareness, or any creative Alateen event.

There continues to be progress and very positive feedback in Alateen meetings on the WSO Mobile App. It is downloadable for iPhones and Android devices. AMIAS participation on the app is in compliance with area requirements for Alateen meetings. Currently there are 5 meetings and are open to all teens but they must have their own App account, and must be on a mobile device. The meetings follow all Area, WSO, and Alateen Service requirements, and the adults attending the app meetings are approved AMIASs. The waiting room for the meeting strictly states it is only for teens 13-18.
