### Copyright & Trademark

At the 2023 WSC, WSO Staff shared a new Copyright & Trademark Protection presentation created in response to the growing number of copyright and trademark violations—particularly on websites, social media platforms, and other digital media—being reported by members globally. Staff designed the presentation to support Conference members in sharing the important message about what constitutes copyright and trademark violations, so each Al-Anon member can inform their groups and events on how to avoid this unintentional harm to Al-Anon as a whole.

#### **COPYRIGHT**

**What**: The exclusive legal right given to an originator to print, publish, perform, film or record a piece of work

**Why**: Protects the collective wisdom of Al-Anon members

**How**: Ensuring only the entity which owns the rights can legally use it




