

AAPP & Alateen Coordinator Report for P55 May Assembly 2015.

The 2015 Alateen Conference is scheduled for June 12 – 14 in Ft Lauderdale FL. The theme is “Recovery Thru Nature” and the event will be held at the La Quinta Hotel. Registration is \$125.00 per person which includes 5 meals and 2 nights lodging on Friday & Saturday, there will be a dance and outdoor activities on Saturday. An ice cream social, and water activities are also scheduled. Registration forms are located on the afgarea9 website.

The task force will meet again either before or at AWSC to decide whether or not to leave the old forms on the website, take them off the website or gray them out (specifically the 2014 AMIAS Form and the 2014 district Certification Form). We have also collected names from DR's for all the people who are authorized signers for each district (for above form).

We have been keeping busy and using progress for the greatest number these are the things we are working on.

There are 3 Task Forces relating to Alateen that will each report to the AWSC panel in August. One has already been charged the other two charges will be worked on throughout the panel.

1. Task Force on Alateen Forms. Discuss needs, opinions and recommendations for how the forms for certification/re-certification will be completed to simplify the processes. (As mentioned above with trial form).

2. Task Force on Background Check frequency. During Panel 52 we determined that once per panel was enough. We need this decision now. It has to be brought to AWSC as a recommendation, discussed and voted on then sent to Assembly.

3. Task Force on Creating Alateen Round Up Guidelines. We do not have any Guidelines for the Area, and District 11 has volunteered to put on a Roundup this summer. The Task Force will create some Temporary Guidelines for this Event, much like the Temporary Guidelines for Hospitality, and then get feedback from the District after the event. The Task Force will report to AWSC and make recommendations for adopting Guidelines.
