Rationale

Since 2022, the Area Convention Committee has included chairs and volunteers from multiple Districts. This area-wide approach is not reflected in the current Area Guidelines.

Previously, a single District would volunteer to host the event, typically drawing all chairs and volunteers from within their District. The Area Convention Guidelines, last updated in August 2019, still reflect this single-district approach.

This Task Force will consider changing the Convention Guidelines, adding information specific to the area-wide approach, and determining whether the information on the area-wide approach should replace the single-district approach.

It will also review the current Convention Committee Chair Responsibilities, adding new chair positions, updating existing ones, or removing ones that are no longer needed. The Task Force can share this information with the current and past chairs if it wishes to do so.
