



Alternate Delegate Report AWSC July 20, 2024 (Virtual) Panel 64

Hello, my name is Mary Walsh and I am honored to fill the role of Alternate Delegate for Area 9 during this Panel, 64. My home group is Discovering Choices, which meets at 7pm on Thursday nights in Clermont. Please stop in if you happen to be in the area.

I'm so excited for the 2nd AWSC of this 1st year of Panel 64. We have accomplished so much and the 1st year of the Panel is not over yet! As Alternate Delegate I am the Area *Forum* Coordinator. My goal is to encourage every member in the North Florida Area to subscribe, read, use and submit writings to *The Forum* as a relevant part of their recovery. I think the Forum is a great tool for meeting topics.

I receive monthly *Forum* sales reports, which summarize monthly *Forum* sales. For June to July in Florida North, 62 copies were mailed to 56 Groups and 695 copies were mailed to 682 individuals for a total of 757 copies of The Forum being mailed out to members residing in Area 9.

That means some groups and individuals, such as myself, are ordering multiple copies.

I think it would be fun if 14 more groups subscribed to the *Forum* to bring the Group total to 70, in honor of the *Forum's* 70th year in publication. And if 18 more individuals subscribed that would bring the total to 700 individuals in North Florida subscribing to the Forum.

You may find that, at the Chairperson’s discretion, time may be extended for certain agenda items throughout the Assembly, however, given the spiritual nature of our RL/GL guidelines, no such extensions are made during the RL/GL portion of Assembly. There is always time at the end of the session for Open Microphone, where any unaddressed questions, comments and concerns may be addressed.
