I receive monthly *Forum* sales reports, which summarize monthly *Forum* sales. For December 61 Groups subscribed to the Forum receiving 67 copies, which means about 6 Groups are ordering more than one copy.

For individual copies 666 people subscribe to the Forum receiving 727 copies, which means many people order more than 1 copy.

These figures do not include digital copies.

For the entire state of Florida 1,230 copies have been mailed out in the month of December.
